Overview

This is Shari Bach, founder of Paws Unlimited, a Kingston animal shelter.

Shari loves dogs. She loves the environment. And she loves her ultra-efficient electric geothermal heating and cooling system.

Central Hudson helped make this project a reality by pitching in approximately \$10,000 through our heat pump incentive program.

In addition, ground-source heat pumps projects can also qualify for federal tax credits of 10% for businesses and 30% for homeowners, while New York State offers a residential-only tax credit of 25%, or up to \$5,000. These tax credits are applied to the total system cost.

Ground-source heat pumps (like Shari's) operate at up to 600% efficiency and parts of these systems can last up to 50 years. That means decades of extremely cost-effective heating and cooling.
