

Town of Poughkeepsie

Main installation will continue the week of **9/1/25** on **Route 9** (between **Spackenkill Road** and **Evergreen Avenue**). This work will be performed at night. There will be lane closures and traffic will be regulated by flaggers.

Main installation will continue the week of **9/1/25** on **West Cedar Street** (between **Fairview Avenue** and **Campus View Drive**). Expect lane closures and traffic regulated by flaggers.

Service installations will begin the week of **9/1/25** on **Wilmar Terrace** (between **Fairview Avenue** and **Buckingham Ave**). Expect lane closures and traffic regulated by flaggers.
