

5/8/26 Update

Town of Shawangunk

Construction is complete on **Walkkill Avenue, Crittenden Street, and Hulse Street**. Restoration will begin **mid-April**. Paving is expected to begin in early June.

City of Kingston

Gas main installation will continue the week of **5/11/26** on **Albany Avenue** (between **South Manor Avenue** and **St. James Court**) with lane changes and/or closures.

Service replacements will begin **5/11/26** on **Albany Avenue** (between **South Manor Avenue** and **Ten Broeck Ave**).

Pre-construction premise inspections will continue the week of **5/11/26**. (**Contractor may ask for access to homes/businesses to perform inside inspections of utilities**).

Village of Fishkill/Town of Fishkill

Construction will begin the week of **5/11/26** on **Jackson Street** (between **Main Street** and **Florence Avenue**). Expect lane closures, traffic will be regulated by flagging staff.

Construction will continue the week of **5/11/26** on **Florence Avenue** (between **Jackson Street** and **Wellesley Place**), **Wood Place** (between **Florence Avenue** and **Weston Avenue**), **Weston Avenue** (between **Wood Place** and **Jackson Street**) and **Cary Avenue** (between **Weston Avenue** and **Main Street**). Expect lane closures, traffic will be regulated by flagging staff.

City of Newburgh

Tie ins/retirements will continue the week of **5/11/26** on **South Street** and **Robinson Avenue/Rt 9W** with lane changes and road closures.

Main installation will continue the week of **5/11/26** on **Broadway** with lane changes.

Service installations will begin the week of **5/11/26** on **Broadway** with lane changes.

Town of Newburgh

Construction is complete and restoration work is expected to begin.

Village of Montgomery

Service installations will continue the week of **5/11/26** on **Railroad Avenue, Sears Street, Wavy Willow Lane** and **Senior Street** with lane changes and road closures.
