
WHERE HOMES WASTE ENERGY

EmPower+ offers free energy efficiency upgrades for income-eligible households, helping lower energy costs and improve comfort. During a home energy assessment, certified contractors identify necessary improvements and confirm eligibility for the program: **nyserda.ny.gov/empower**.
