EV Make Ready

Incentives covering up to 100% of the costs of EV charger infrastructure.

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Clean Heat

Incentives to install efficient heat pump systems.

Incentives on heat pump systems are available for businesses of all sizes.

- All projects with projected heating loads >300,000 BTUh of heating capacity and all multi-family projects with 5 or more units must follow the custom pathway if one of the following statements are true: (1) The project involves installing NEEP-listed cold climate central air source or mini-split units, or ENERGY STAR-compliant GSHPs at new construction and existing multifamily buildings. (2) The project proposes to install a mix of the above heat pump technologies. Your contractor will be able to take care of this.
- All multi-family projects (5-99 units) are eligible for a \$ / dwelling unit rebate.
- To be eligible for incentives, custom projects must complete electrification and startup of all mechanical systems being incentivized by the date specified in the utility's Offer Letter.
- For custom projects to be completed after 12/31/25, Contractors are encouraged to share information with their Central Hudson account manager.
- To be eligible for a rebate, a qualifying system must be installed by a certified Clean Heat contractor, a list of which can be found on the Find A Contractor page.



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Energy Efficiency

Incentives for upgrading specific equipment.

- Prescriptive Program: Generally for larger customers and customers that need to make substantial improvements to their lighting system, HVAC, and refrigeration equipment. Includes incentives on common equipment with set incentive amounts for each. Can be used only for replacing existing components, not new construction. - Custom Program: Incentives available for custom applications, including many types of industries. New construction is eligible as well.
