## Central Hudson's Pole Attachment Process

- Attacher submits application on NJUNS. (Includes the application form and walk sheet)
- Attachers send in payment at this time. Checks are received in the mail. CH has 5 business days to process application once received.

## Step 2

- A J-Log is created to track the progress of the job.
- •The information is sent to Estimating, and field reviews are completed by the estimators assigned to the job. CH has a minimum of 45 (\*see below) business days to complete the field review.

- Once the field review is complete, CH has 14 business days to notify the attacher.
- If there is no Make Ready involved, CH can license the job and send the license to the attachers for signature.

- If there is Make Ready involved, CH will provide a cost summary and invoice to the attacher.
  Payment should be received within 14 business days.
- The attacher mails in the check, and the job is moved to construction.
- CH has minimum of 45 (\* see below) business days to complete any required field work
- Once construction is complete, the job is licensed. CH has 3 business days from the completion of make ready to issue the license.
