To the Operator:

This is to acknowledge that the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) has received a Notice of Intent (NOI) for coverage under the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) General Permit for Point Source Discharges to Surface Waters of New York from Pesticide Applications - General Permit No. GP-0-11-001 (PGP).

Your NOI has been determined to be complete.

The permit identification number NYP000340 was assigned to this NOI, for the NOI date of receipt of 7/2/2012. This identification number should be used in any future correspondence with the Department concerning the PGP.

Discharges which are consistent with those described in the NOI and in compliance with the requirements of the PGP are authorized five (5) business days from the above date of NOI receipt, unless earlier written notification has been provided by the Department. The period of coverage under the PGP expires on October 31, 2016. You are not required to renew coverage for pesticide discharges during this period, if the discharges are consistent with the NOI.

An annual regulatory fee of \$100 is assessed for each calendar year during the period of coverage under this PGP. The fee will be billed separately by the Department, generally in the Fall of the calendar year for which the fee applies. Do not submit this fee prior to the billing from the Department.

Coverage under the PGP may be terminated by submitting a Notice of Termination (NOT) form to the Department at the same address for the NOI submittal. The permit identification number provided above should be entered on the NOT form. Please note that you will be responsible for the annual regulatory fee in the calendar year that you have filed the NOT. Termination of coverage by submittal of a NOT will terminate regulatory fees for the following calendar year.

If discharges are planned which are not addressed in the NOI (e.g., a pesticide not described in the NOI), the operator is required to submit a new NOI which describes the new discharges. The operator may terminate coverage under the original NOI through submitting a NOT, and submit a new NOI which describes all discharges (including those in the original NOI) in order to maintain a single NOI and a single annual regulatory fee.
